## Photo Contest 2019 Official Rules

1. All photos must be taken at the Norma Johnson Center (NJC).
2. There will be two different categories. Amateur and Professional
3. The Amateur contest is open to any individual that is not a professional photographer. A professional photographer is someone that receives greater than 50% of income from photography.
4. The Professional contest is open to any individual that receives 50% of their income from photography.
5. Photographs may be any size, black and white, color or digital stills. Do not send photo reproductions. No digital imaging (alteration) but enhancing (recoloring, changing contrast) is acceptable. Must send a hard copy.
6. No more than three photographs may be submitted by an individual.
7. An entrant information card must accompany the photo. Please include the following information:
  - a) Photographer's name, address and phone number
  - b) Title of photo
  - c) Location of photograph on the Norma Johnson Center property
8. All entries become property of the Norma Johnson Conservation Center Foundation Board (NJCCFB). The NJCCFB reserves the non-exclusive right to use all photographs in publications or for promotional purposes. Entrants should keep negatives or extra prints of their photographs.
9. Judges will select a first, second and third place winner based on aesthetic value, technical merit and composition.
10. The winners will be announced at the Norma Johnson Center's Annual Meeting on March 21, 2019. The top winners of the contest will be announced on the NJC Facebook Page and the Norma Johnson Center website on the News page by March 8, 2019. Top winners will be contacted to attend the Annual Meeting on March 21, 2019 where the places will be announced and cash prize awarded. Cash prizes will be determined on number of entries.
11. All entries must be post marked or received by March 2, 2019. Entries can be submitted by mailing or dropping off photos to/ at: 85 East Iron Avenue Dover OH 44622. The NJC office is located in the Soil and Water Conservation District building across from Dominos by the Fairgrounds.
12. The Norma Johnson Conservation Center board is a 501c(3) non-profit organization that is committed to promoting the conservation and preservation of natural resources through education, community outreach and personal experience. The intention of this Photo Contest is to familiarize people with the Norma Johnson Center, the NJC, and the mission of the NJC.
