USER AGREEMENT**

I, _____, (User) acknowledge(s) that I/we have voluntarily requested to use the RED BARN facility, located at the Norma Johnson Center on the Conservation side of the property. This property is owned and operated by Tuscarawas Soil & Water Conservation District and its assignees. User also agrees to abide by the following rules when utilizing this facility:

- No Smoking in or around property.
- No Alcoholic Beverages permitted on premises.
- Party using the facility is responsible to clean up the facility.
- Must comply with maximum capacity requirements (125).
- This policy must be signed by participant prior to usage.
- Failure to comply with this policy/agreement could result in legal action.

By signing this agreement, User agrees to release Tuscarawas Soil & Water Conservation District and its assignees from any and all actions, claims or demands due to injury, death or other damages stemming from the use of the facility. User also agrees to take full responsibility of any property damage that would be done as a direct result of usage of the facility.

I have carefully read this Agreement and fully understand its content. I am aware that it contains a release of liability.

I have read and understand the rules and regulations governing the use of the "RED BARN" facility and I agree to comply with all the rules as stated. I agree to assume all responsibility for any damages incurred beyond normal wear and tear and also assume all liability for personal damages or injuries incurred through use of the facility and relieve the Tuscarawas Soil & Water Conservation District and its officials of any responsibility for such activities.
