

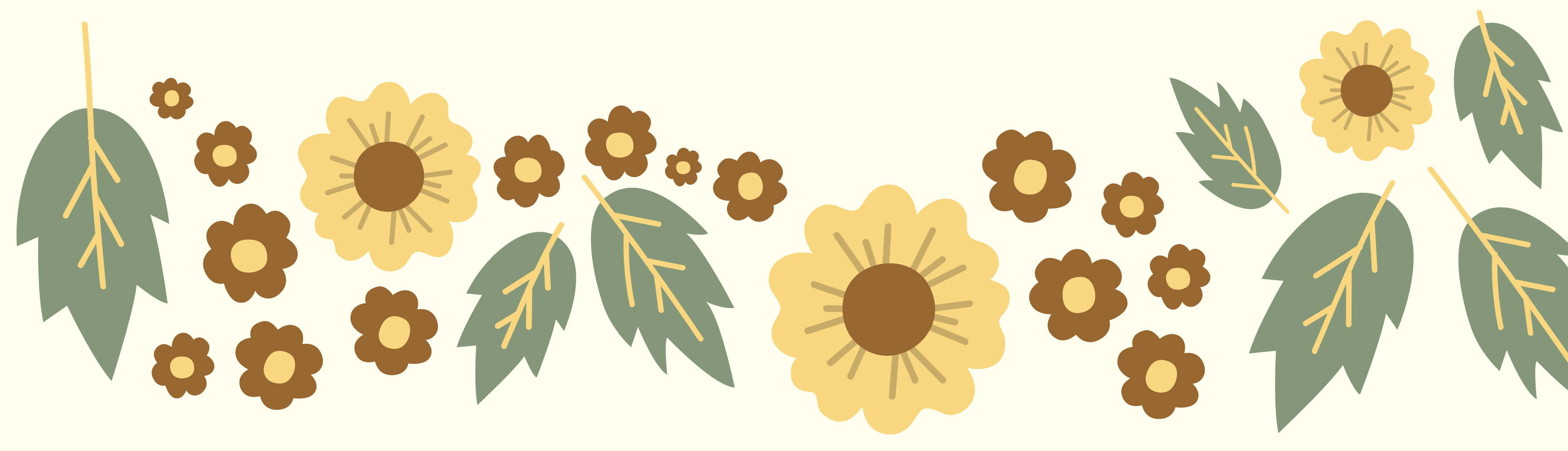



Interacting with Nature: Tuesdays, 10AM-12PM

Meet at Picnic Shelter on Conservation Drive, off of old SR 39

- June 8 – Wildflowers: Join us as we discover the wildflowers at the NJC!
 - June 15 – Pond Dipping [Macro invertebrates]: Come to the wetland and visit the creatures who call it home! Use nets to catch and learn about insects and amphibians and their lives outside and in the water.
 - June 22 – Go Find It: Come explore the NJC as we give you clues to specific items along the trail. Explore, experience, and make memories.
 - June 29 – No program
 - July 6 – Micro Hike: Into the woods we will go to find a spot just for you! It's amazing what happens in nature right under our noses. We would never know it was happening until we stopped and explored! Join us to explore the different mysteries of nature.
 - July 13 – Butterflies: Have you ever fed a butterfly? Visit our special exhibit for your chance to walk among nature's most beautiful and delicate pollinators.
 - July 20 – Nature Sense: Using our senses, we will explore the natural environment that surrounds us. How do other critters in nature use their senses? How do we use our senses?
